Francesco Prota (Ph.D. in Agricultural and Environmental Economics, University of Naples 'Parthenope'; M.Phil. in Environmental and Sustainable Development, University of Glasgow) is Lecturer in Economics at the University of Bari "Aldo Moro" (Italy) and member of the teaching board of the Doctoral School in Economics, Management and Quantitative Methods at the University of Salento. He has extensive experience teaching both at undergraduate level (Macroeconomics and Development Economics) and at postgraduate level (Development Economics). His research interests include development economics; public policy



evaluation; innovation economics; regional economics and international economic integration. He is author of several articles in economics journals, including *World Development*, *Regional Studies, Papers in Regional Science, Journal of International Development*, *Development Policy Review, Economics Letters, European Planning Studies, Economia Politica.* Journal of Analytical and Institutional Economics. Besides serving as referee for international journals, he is Associate Editor for Regional Studies, Regional Science and for L'Industria. Review of Industrial Economics and Policy.

Since 2011, he has been acting as consultant to UNIDO (United Nations Industrial Development Organization) on several research projects (mainly on cluster development and FDI in Africa). He has also a long track record of collaboration with different Italian government departments and agencies (Public Investment Evaluation Unit of the Department for Development Policies and Economic Cohesion; Department for the Planning and Coordination of Economic Policy - Presidency of the Council of Ministers; Formez; Sviluppo Italia; Unit for the Evaluation of Public Investments of the Apulia Region).
